DAY 1

PORTLAND ART SILO'S / ABERCROMBIE HOUSE TOUR



We depart from our central pick up point in a fully air-conditioned 5 star Touring Coach with toilet on board.

We will travel along the Bells Line Road, before our first morning tea stop at Mt Tomah Botanical Gardens, the only Botanic Garden in Australia located in a UNESCO World Heritage Area

Afterwards it's on to The Portland Silos, now known as "The Foundations" which were the 20th Silos to be included in the Australian Silo Art Trail and were completed in May 2018.

The old Portland Cement Works were painted by Guido van Helten and depict five male and one female past Portland Cement workers.

Leaving here we visit The historical Abercrombie House & Garden in Bathurst for a historical tour & lunch with the owner, Chris Morgan..

We will then visit the infamous Mt Panorama race track for a "lap of honour" ahead of checking into our accommodation at the adjacent Rydges Mt Panorama Bathurst..

Pre dinner drinks & dinner will be served in the Motel's Chicane's Bar & Grill Restaurant.



DAY 2

A TASTE OF ORANGE

After breakfast at leisure, we will depart for the country city of Orange. It's a place known for its elegant tree-lined streets, charming heritage building, fresh farm produce and high altitude wine district. A city rich in history, including the nearby birthplace of our famous poet, Banjo Patterson.

We will meet our local guide for a tour of the city, before allowing some free time to explore the city shops and crafts.

Lunch will be enjoyed at the historic Duntryleague Guest House, one of the region's premier venues and regarded by many as the most elegant landmark in Orange.



Afterwards, we will take the scenic drive to the majestic Lake Canobolas and the Pinnacle Lookout overlooking the surrounding region's wine district.

The afternoon will be completed with a wine tasting at the iconic Philip Shaw Winery.

Nestled beside a 130-year-old barn, the renowned Koomooloo Vineyard, planted in 1989, stands as one of the highest and coolest in Australia.

We will be hosted by a cellar door team member, together with a plate featuring local cheese, handmade lavash and accompaniments.

It's then back to our Motel for a well earned rest, ahead of dinner at our Motel's Chicane's Bar & Grill Restaurant.

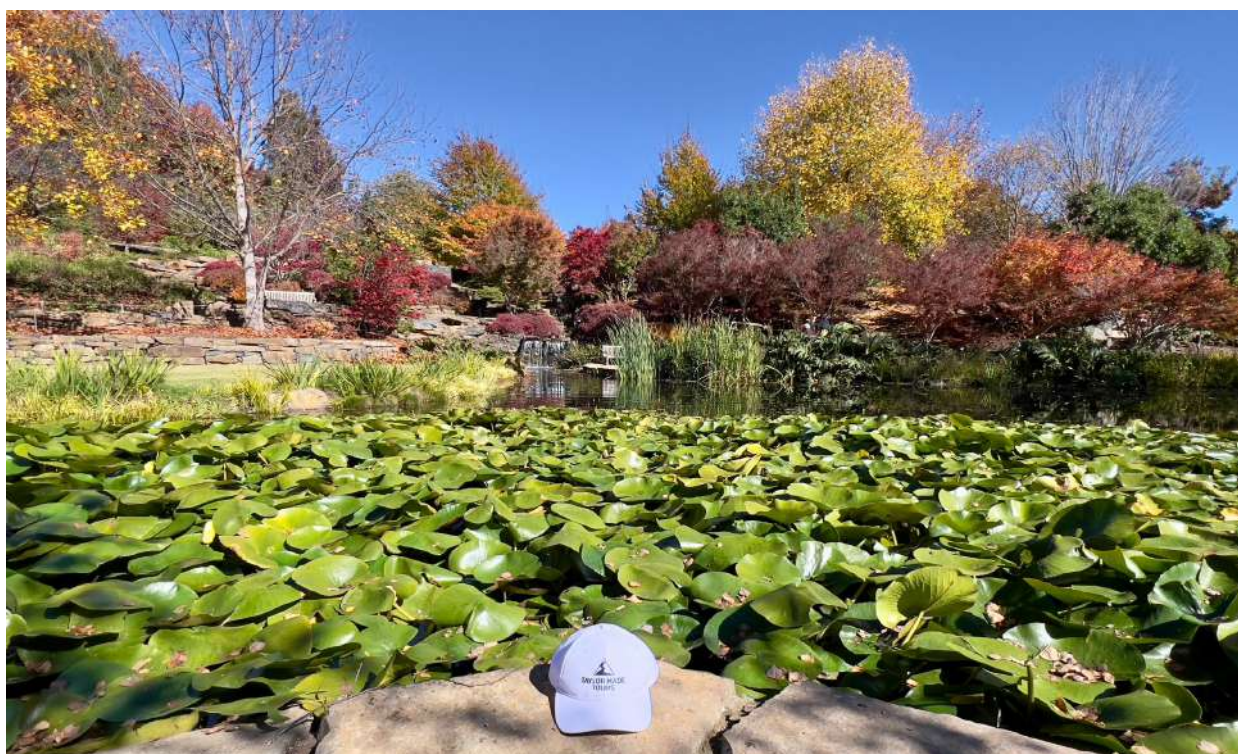


DAY 3

MAYFIELD GARDENS
