## DAY 1

SUNDAY

## HERVEY BAY / FRASER ISLAND

Depart from Sydney Airport for our morning flight via Brisbane to Hervey Bay.

On arrival, our coach will pick us up from the airport for a short transfer to River Heads for our mid afternoon barge crossing The Great Sandy Strait to Fraser Island.

Upon check in, we will be welcomed by our hosts and later enjoy a complimentary drink at the Sunset Bar before dinner at the Sand & Wood Restaurant at the **Kingfisher Resort, Fraser Island**, our accommodation for the next 3 nights.

After dinner there is a magnificent 20 minute sky light show highlighting the regeneration of Fraser Island (K'gari). It's the first permanent light, laser and projection installation of its kind in Queensland. **(D)**



## DAY 2

## FRASER ISLAND ECO TOUR

A leisurely start this morning before enjoying a buffet breakfast in the Resort Restaurant. Our 4WD coach will collect us from our hotel doorstep and take us on a wonderful day-long eco tour of this beautiful island with our guide for the day. We will visit Central Station Forest Park, Lake McKenzie, Wanggoolba Creek, and Pile Valley.

A buffet lunch awaits us back at the Resort before we head along the surf beach to visit the famous SS Maheno Shipwreck and then the outcrop of coloured sands known as “The Pinnacles”.



We make a stop at Eli Creek for those who may want a swim in its refreshing spring waters, before later that afternoon, we will make our way back home to refresh and share our experiences ahead of dinner at the Resort Restaurant. **(B, L, D)**

## DAY 3

## TUESDAY

## WHALE WATCH CRUISE



Today's the day when we watch the whales frolic. After a buffet breakfast we will board our vessel for an exciting day cruising around the crystal clear waters of Hervey Bay. We will be out in the bay this morning looking at 40 tonne female humpback whales, caring for their young as they wave and slap the surface with their huge tails ahead of their southerly migration to the colder waters of the Southern Ocean.

Morning tea will be served on board the vessel. Upon our return to the resort, lunch will be served at the Sand Bar.

The afternoon is free for either just relaxing by the pool, exploring the K'gari World Heritage Centre or perhaps a bird watching walk in the nearby natural surroundings. Dinner will be served at the Resort Restaurant. **(B, L, D)**

## DAY 4

## WEDNESDAY

## BUNDABERG / AGNES WATERS

A nice easy morning as we leave the island for our mid morning transfer back to River Heads. Our coach will travel through the heart of sugar cane country to Bundaberg, a place known as Rum City and the gateway to the Southern Great Barrier Reef.

We will enjoy a seafood lunch overlooking the Burnett River before visiting the famous Bundaberg Rum Distillery thereafter. The brand is home to Australia's iconic rum, dating back to 1888, ahead of a museum and guided distillery tour experience.



Afterwards it's on to Agnes Waters, close to Captain Cook's first landing point in Queensland, staying at **1770 Central Lagoon Resort** for the next 2 nights. Dinner will be served on site at the Plantation Bar & Restaurant. **(B, L, D)**

## DAY 5

## THURSDAY

## AGNES WATERS / 1770 CRUISE



After a leisurely start, breakfast will be served at the Plantation Restaurant ahead of our exploration of the nearby Eurimbula National Park. Our tour will commence from the town of 1770 located between Bundaberg & Gladstone. Our transport is an Amphibious Vessel (known as a Larc), originally built for military use transporting troops around coastal areas during the war.

Our journey today takes us across two tidal creeks along the foreshore, where the only footprints in the golden sands are your own. You will learn about the local history,

culture, flora and fauna. Keep an eye out for the prolific wildlife (including kangaroos, dolphins, turtles & sea eagles) that inhabit the area. This unique experience includes a picnic lunch and a chance to take a refreshing swim in the turquoise waters of Bustard Bay.

We leave here for our resort back in Agnes Waters to either relax by the resort pool or explore the township. Dinner will be served at the resort restaurant. **(B, L, D)**

## DAY 6

## FRIDAY

## ROCKHAMPTON BOTANICAL GARDENS / YEPPON

After breakfast we will travel to the town of Gladstone, known as one of Australia's largest commodity export ports, for coal, alumina, oil & gas that serve the Bowen & Cooper Basins.

On arrival, we will stop at Round Hill Lookout, enjoying the diverse views it offers of the Gladstone township.

We push further north to Rockhampton, the Beef Capital of Australia. The magnificent Botanical Gardens await as we enjoy lunch in a leafy setting, before a walk through the magnificent gardens. We will tour the city before making our way to pay homage to the open air non-denominational St Christopher's Chapel, built by US soldiers during WWII back in 1943.



We leave here for Yeppoon, the heart of The Capricorn Coast via the coastal drive past Emu Park and Rosslyn Bay, before checking into our accommodation at **The Bayfield Towers, Yeppoon**, for the next 2 nights, overlooking the Keppel Islands. **(B, L, D)**

## DAY 7

## SATURDAY

## GREAT KEPPELL ISLAND



After breakfast we depart for the Marina for our coral lunch cruise to Great Keppel Island. The day starts mid morning on a 30 minute Fast Cat before arriving on the Island

Morning tea will be served upon arrival, before we transfer to our Glass Bottom Boat Coral Viewing Cruise. During this time, our expert guides will provide an informative commentary about the history behind Great Keppel Island and surrounding marine life.

A delicious lunch is served on board the ferry.

We end the day exploring the island village, including a browse in the souvenir shops, having a swim or simply relaxing on Keppel's pristine white beaches before returning to Yeppoon mid afternoon. Dinner will be served at our accommodation. **(B, L, D)**

## DAY 8

## SUNDAY

## ROCKHAMPTON / HOME

An early breakfast as we farewell The Capricorn Coast. We will depart for Rockhampton Airport, along Yeppoon Rd, via the Baga National Park, and its unique volcanic plugs, for our mid morning flight, arriving back in Sydney early that afternoon. **(B)**
