DAY 1 SUNDAY

BRAIDWOOD / BATEMANS BAY

The group will leave from a central pick up point in Sydney and travel down the Hume Hwy.

Morning tea is in Belmore Park, Goulburn in the Southern Tablelands, proclaimed as Australia's first inland city.

We travel further south and have a BBQ lunch at the historic Braidwood, noted as a heritage-listed town that transports visitors back in time with its well-preserved colonial architecture and historic sites. There will be some free time to wander the town's main street, lined with 19th-century buildings including the nearby "much to do about chocolate shop".

We will then make our way to the coastal town of Batemans Bay via Holmes Lookout for our two night stay. All our meals will be in the motel's much acclaimed Trappers Restaurant. **L,D**

DAY 2 MONDAY

BATEHAVEN / MOGO / CLYDE RIVER LUNCHEON CRUISE



This morning we will take the scenic George Bass coastal drive through Batehaven, Malua Bay, Mossy Point, Broulee and visit Mogo Town for morning tea. There is time to walk through this quaint town with its unique craft shops.

After leaving here it's back to Batemans Bay to board the "Clyde Princess" for our late morning guided cruise to Nelligen, located on the banks of the Clyde River. Local fish and chip lunch with salad will be served on board the vessel.

There is some free time thereafter to explore the riverside charm of this coastal town. **B,L,D**

DAY 3 TUESDAY

BODALLA / NAROOMA / TILBA / BERMAGUI / EDEN



After breakfast, we will say good bye to our host at Batemans Bay, head south on the Princess Hwy and stop at Bodalla. Visit local attractions such as the Bodalla Dairy shed and Lavender shop.

We continue south to the seaside town of Narooma visiting the Bar Rock lookout for morning tea while taking in the scenic breakwater coastal views. Next stop is the colourful hillside village of Tilba. The entire village is classified by the National Trust. Famous for Tilba cheese, you will be amazed by the myriad of novelty shops and galleries operated by dedicated

locals including the heritage listed Dromedary Hotel (named after nearby Mt Dromedary).

A BBQ lunch by the water is enjoyed at the nearby seaside fishing town of Bermagui. Our tour continues south via Tathra, Meribula and Pambula where at the latter, we can stretch our legs.

It's then off to our accommodation in Eden for the next two nights. All our meals will be in the motels restaurant. **B,L,D**

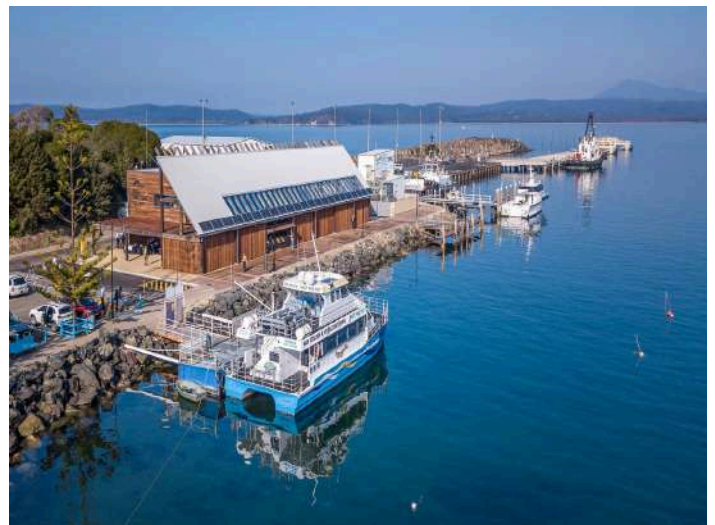
DAY 4 WEDNESDAY

TWOFOLD BAY CRUISE / KILLER WHALE MUSEUM

A hot buffet breakfast can be enjoyed at your leisure before we leave this morning at 10.30am for our 2 hr morning guided cruise on Twofold Bay. We get a chance to be up close and personal with dolphins, seals and many species of seabirds.

Every journey is different and sometimes we are lucky enough to spot marine creatures like penguins, flying fish, turtles and sharks. Twofold Bay, surrounded by the beautiful Beowa National Park, is the third deepest in the southern Hemisphere.

A BBQ lunch is enjoyed at Eden Rotary Park overlooking Twofold Bay. After lunch we will then visit the Killer Whale Museum in town.



It's then off to Ben Boyd Tower and the old Davidson Whaling Station, last operated in 1929. Afterwards we head into town for a well earned rest before dinner. **B,L,D**

DAY 5 THURSDAY

BEGA / COOMA / CANBERRA / YASS

After breakfast we bid farewell to our host, as we will drive north to the Bega Heritage Centre

The Centre was built in 1993 and is a faithful reproduction of the original 'creamery' building constructed in 1899. At the Centre you can sample and purchase a selection of Bega Cheese.

We head inland on the Snowy Mountain Hwy where you'll notice a notable change in the landscape ahead of morning tea in Cooma.



We follow the Monaro Hwy to the National Gallery in Canberra for lunch.

The National Gallery of Australia (NGA) in Canberra is the country's premier art museum, home to over 155,000 works of art. In February 2027, the gallery features a mix of high-energy blockbusters and significant retrospectives.

The National Portrait Gallery is right next door to the NGA. It's a more intimate experience focusing on the faces that shaped Australia—from musicians and athletes to scientists and politicians.

There will be time this afternoon to explore and enjoy the various exhibits on display

It's then off to our 4 star accommodation in Yass. Meals are on site at the Motels restaurant. **B,L,D**

DAY 7 FRIDAY

COOMA COTTAGE / GOULBURN / HOME

After a leisurely breakfast we will visit the historical home built in 1839 of the famous explorer Hamilton Hume at Cooma Cottage in Yass.

Visitors can walk through Hume's original house and soak up the stories of pioneering life in the nineteenth century and enjoy some morning tea thereafter.

We then follow the Hume Highway via The Goulburn Workers Club for lunch before arriving back in Sydney later that afternoon. **B,L**
